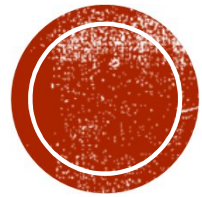

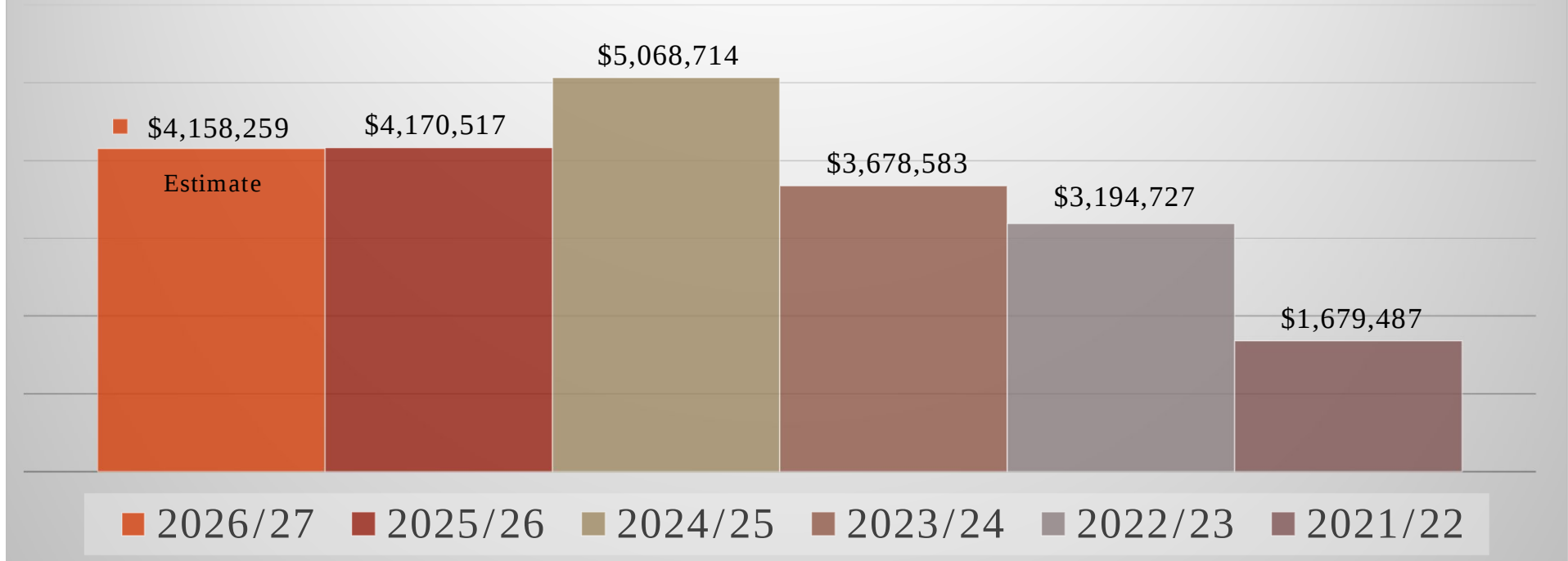

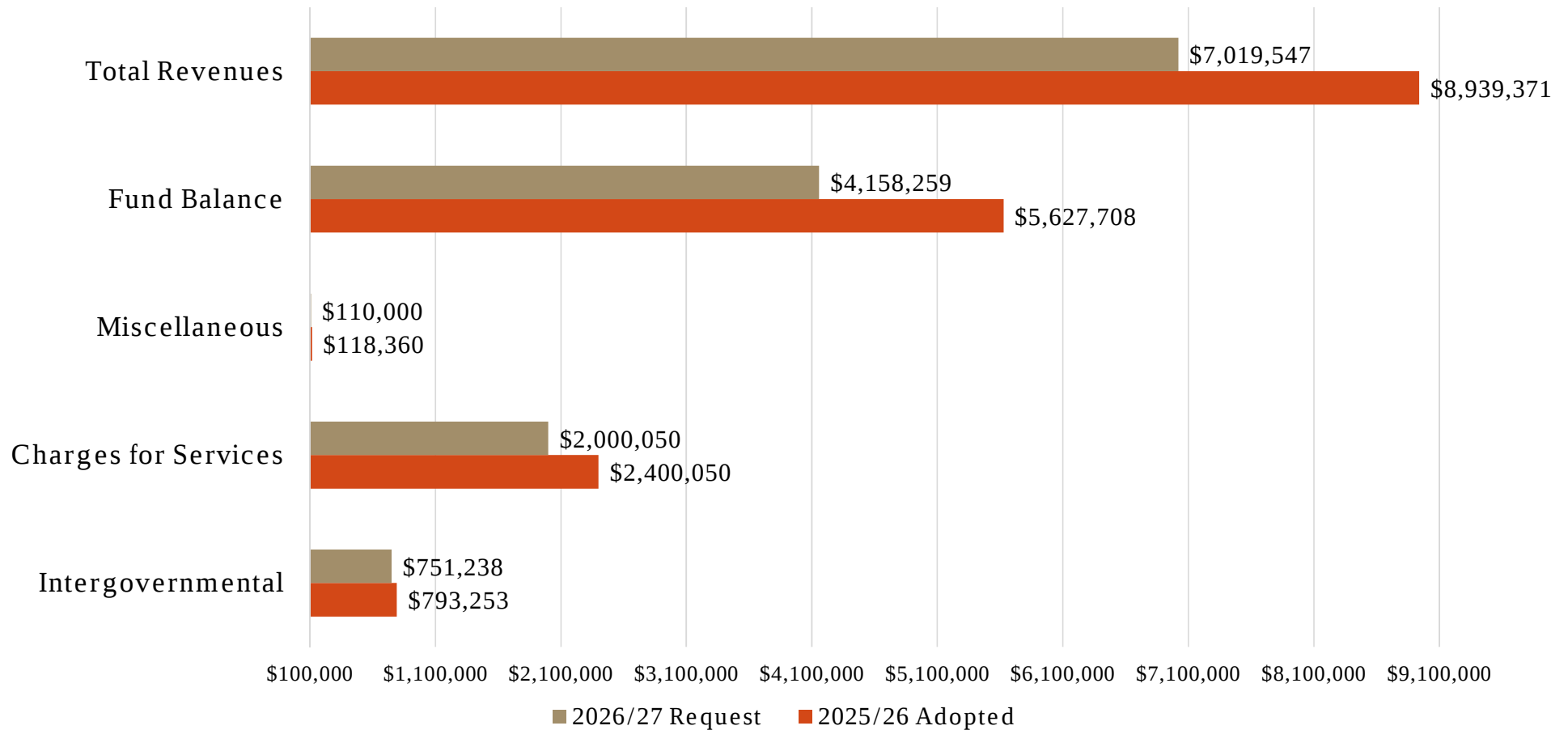

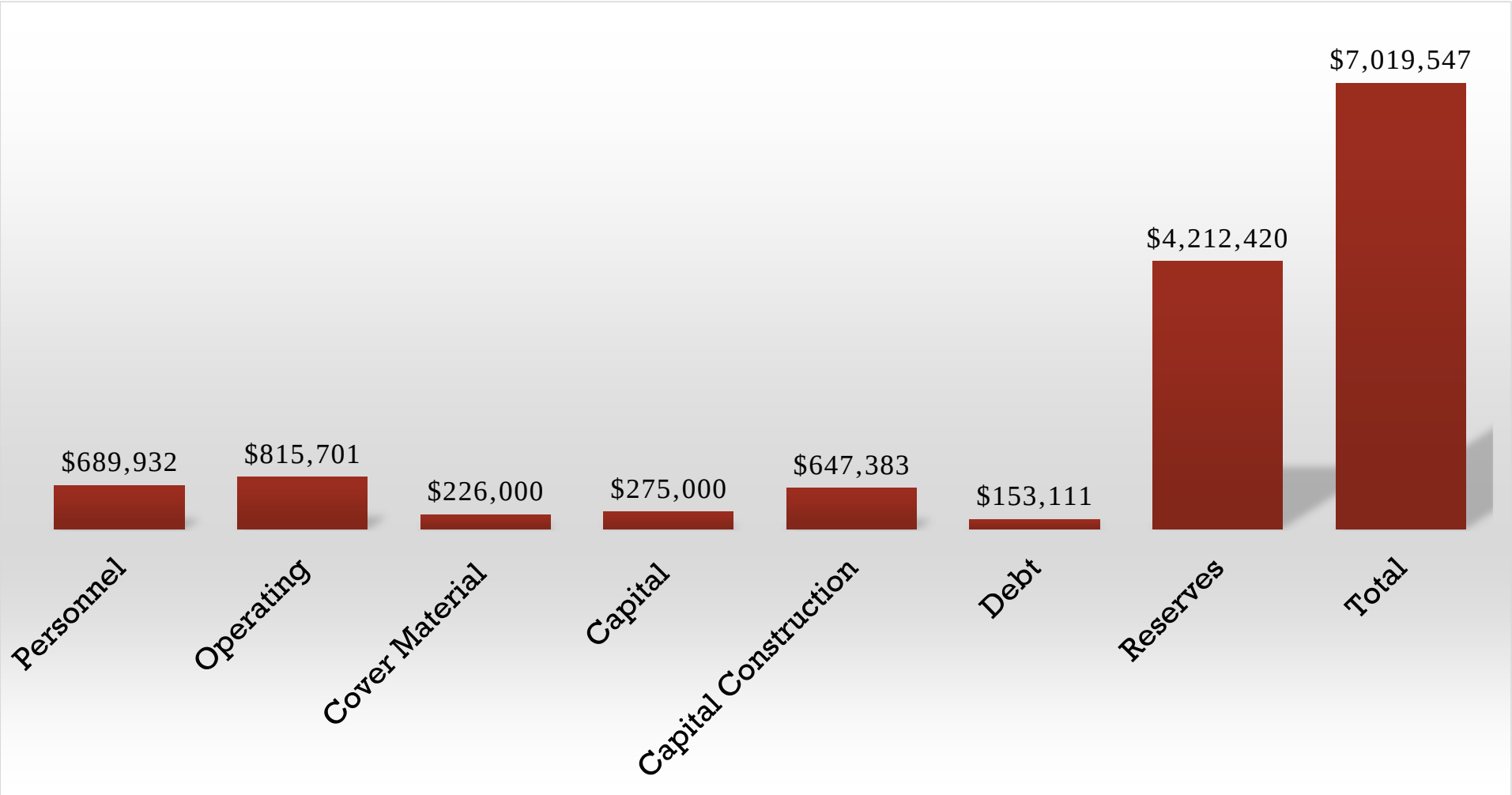
Environmental Services Fund Balance Five Year History with 2026/2027 Budget Estimate



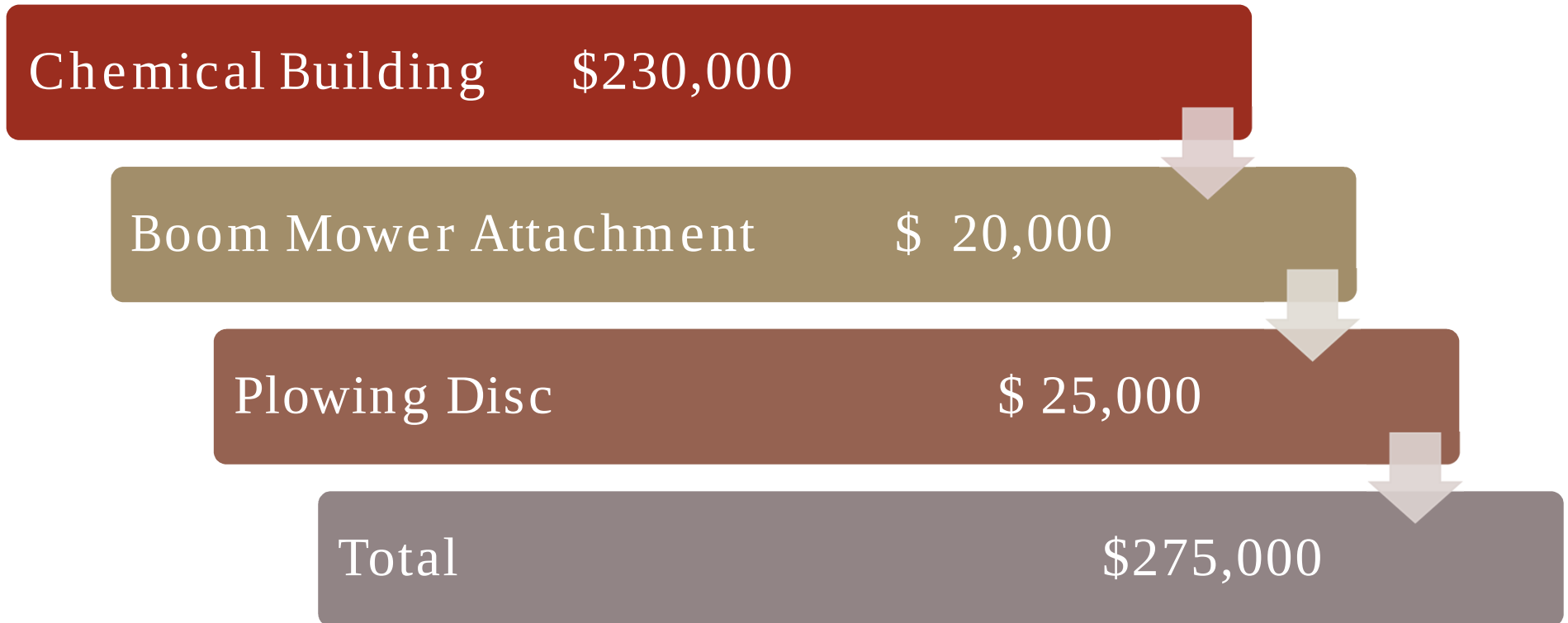
Environmental Services Revenue



Environmental Services Operating



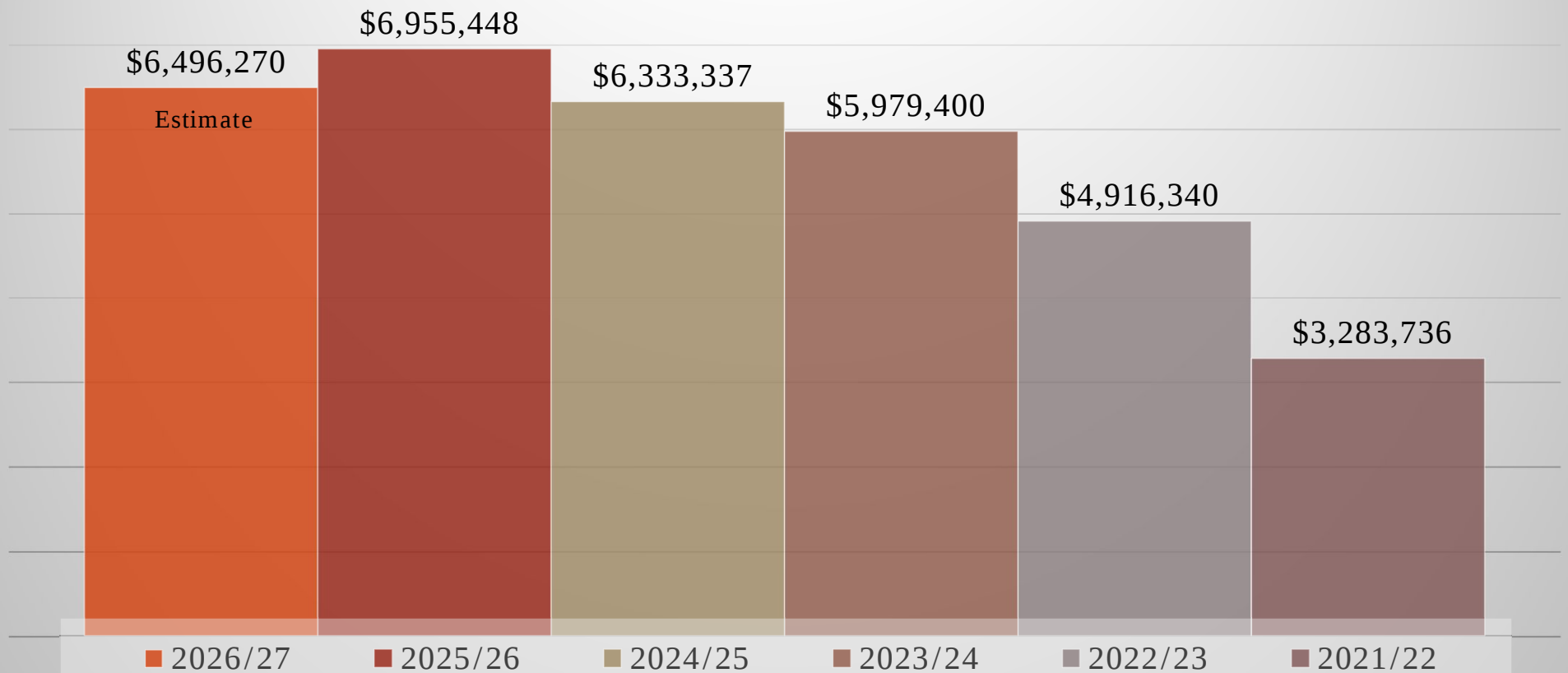

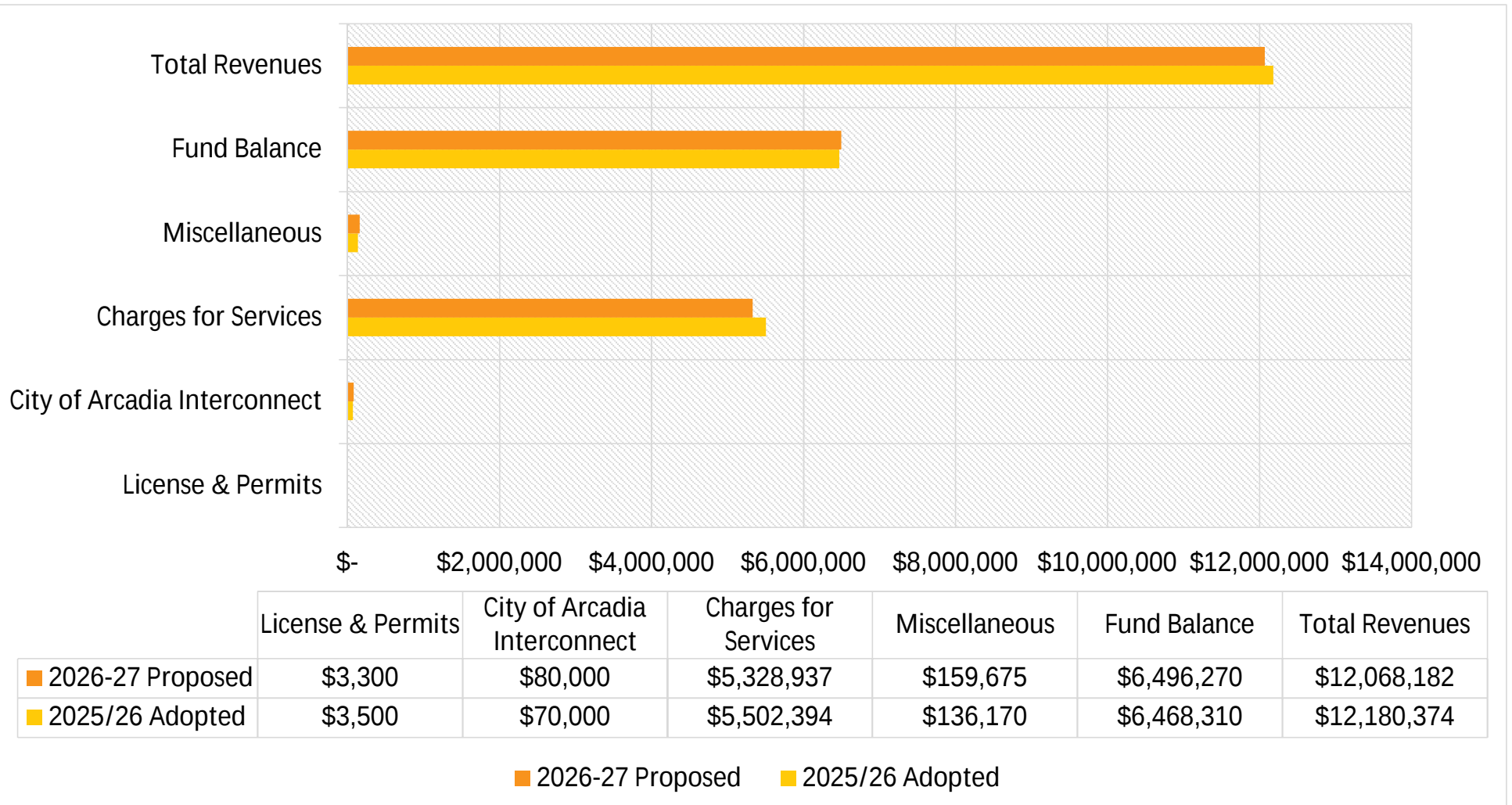

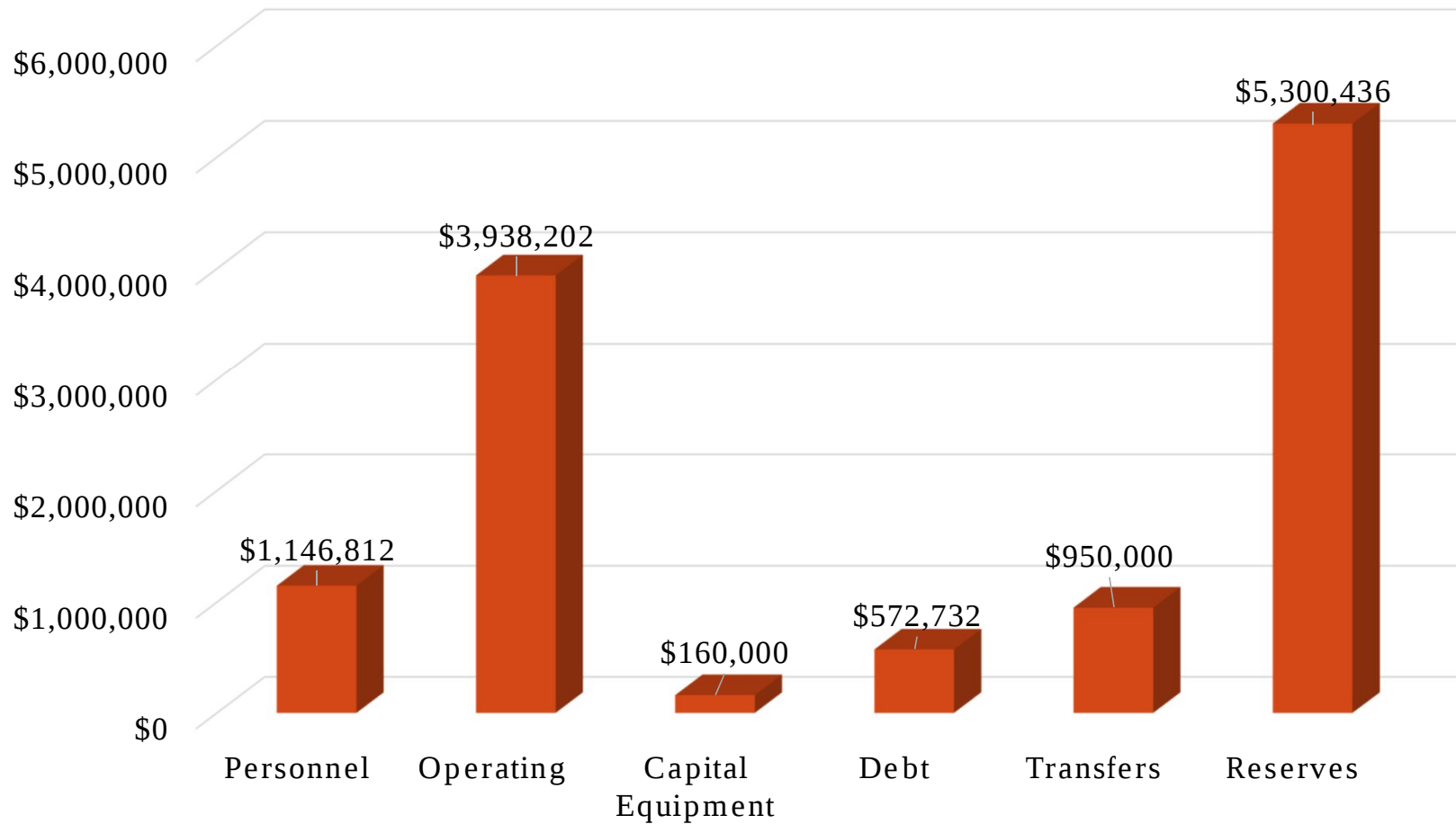
Utilities Operations Fund Balance Five Year History with 2026/2027 Budget Estimate

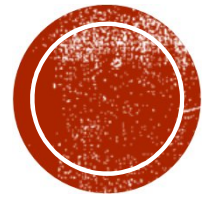

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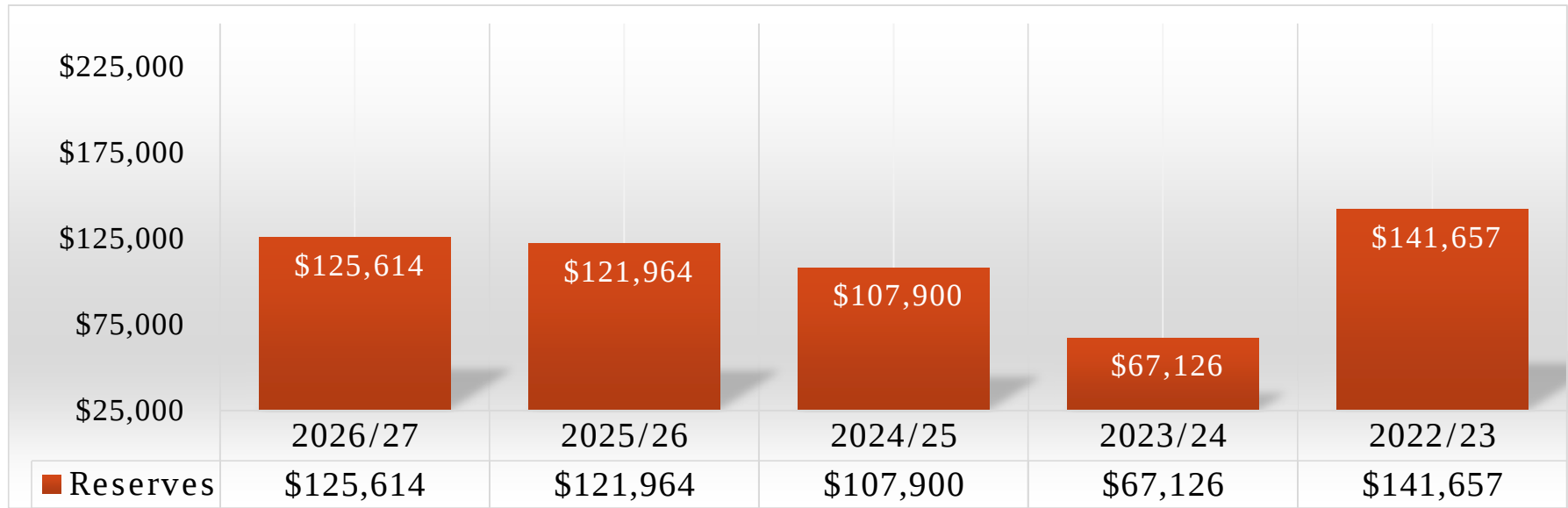
