 - (4) The parking or storage of one commercial vehicle, one piece of equipment or one shipping container.
 - (5) The parking or storage and routine maintenance of one commercial vehicle where the commercial vehicle is used by a resident of the premises if the commercial vehicle has a load capacity of less than two tons, is less than nine feet high (including the load, bed and box) and is less than 30 feet long.
 - (6) For RM zoning districts whose principal use is residential, two commercial vehicles may be parked or stored on the property, and routine maintenance performed, if they are used by a resident of the premises, if each commercial vehicle is parked a minimum of 20 feet from all property boundaries and if the commercial vehicles each have a load capacity of less than two tons, are each less than nine feet high (including the load, bed and box) and are each less than 30 feet long. Upgrades to the culvert, driveway and apron may be required at the discretion of the County Engineer.
- (c) Special exceptions for lots not meeting minimum lot size. The parking of a commercial vehicle with a load capacity of less than two tons, less than nine feet high (including the load, bed and box) and less than 30 feet long, in residential zoning districts on property not meeting minimum lot size may be approved as a special exception provided the requirements listed below are met.

Applications for a special exception pursuant to this section are to be reviewed in accordance with the criteria and procedures for special exceptions set forth in Article XI, Division 5, of this chapter.

- (1) Only one commercial vehicle, one piece of equipment or one shipping container, as regulated by this division, shall be parked on any residential lot or parcel.
- (2) Commercial vehicles shall be currently registered or licensed.

Alfredo Gutierrez (Damaris Ramirez) – DRC Comments – USE-0191-2024 – Special Exception

I. John Osborne, Planning comments:

- 1. The DeSoto County Land Development Regulations is unclear in Section 20-96(d)(1) if more than 1 commercial vehicle with a load capacity of more than two tons, and/or are more than nine feet high, (including the load, bed and box), and/or are more than 30 feet long, may be allowed in residential zoning districts. The applicant will need to make the case for two commercial vehicles before the Board hearing for approval of the Special Exception use.
- 2. Each vehicle must be parked a minimum of 20 feet from all property boundaries. Please show this on the site plan.
- 3. Upgrades to the culvert, driveway and apron may be required at the discretion of the County Engineer.
- 4. Upon approval of the special exception by the BOCC, per Section 20-96(d)(2), approvals shall be valid for one year, or for a shorter period as specified by the Board of County Commissioners. Approvals may be administratively renewed, with proper application, following notice provided to the Development Director no less than 30 days prior to the expiration date, if the commercial vehicle location is consistent with the land development regulations and conditions of approval. The applicant shall bear the burden in demonstrating that the vehicle parking still meets the criteria of the approved special exception and this section.

II. FDOH Environmental Services, comments:

Desoto Dept. of Health has no comment.

III. Legal Don Conn, comments:

This SE application can be approved if it complies with LDR 20-96. The first question is whether the parcel meets the minimum lot size. If it does, then subsection (b)(6) applies and the requirements set forth must be met. If it does not, then subsection (c) applies and those requirements must be met

V. <u>Building Official Lester Hornbake, Jr. comments:</u>

VI. <u>DeSoto County Engineer Mike Giardullo, PE comments:</u>

Based on the application, this property is zoned RMF-M and complies with the minimum lot size under code Sec. 20-131, therefore, I am reviewing based on code Sec 20-96(b)(6) for parking or storage of vehicles in residential districts.

The code restricts the owner in RM zoning districts with residential principal use tto two commercial vehicles. To be sure, the applicant indicates the improvements are "1 dump truck, 1 semi w/ trailer, park two commercial vehicles". Am I correct in understanding it is two commercial vehicles total?

The diagram is not clear, I recommend they demonstrate that they can fit both vehicles at least 20' from the property line. Based on review of the site, this may be challenging given existing trees on site. The parking location of the vehicles should reflect the actual size.

This code section requires that each vehicle has a load capacity of less than two tons. The types of vehicles indicated typically have a greater load capacity. I Recommend the applicant review and comment whether they are able to comply with this section.

Although a recently constructed driveway exists, it is not compliant with County requirements for commercial traffic. Upgrades will be required and the driveway will have to be resurfaced in accordance with the County commercial driveway standards or an agreed upon alternative. The applicant should demonstrate how they can access and exit the site with the commercial vehicles without off-tracking from the roadway/driveway. The applicant should be aware that backing out commercial vehicles into the County roadway is not typically allowed.
