BY TRUCKS WITH A RATED LOAD CAPACITY IN EXCESS
OF ONE TON ON TURNER AVENUE FROM STATE ROAD NO.
70 NORTH TO STATE ROAD NO 35 (U.S. NO. 17).

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DESOTO COUNTY, FLORIDA, PROHIBITING THROUGH TRUCK TRAFFIC BY TRUCKS WITH A RATED LOAD CAPACITY IN EXCESS OF ONE TON ON TURNER AVENUE FROM STATE ROAD NO. 70 NORTH TO STATE ROAD NO. 35 (U.S. NO. 17).

WHEREAS,

the Board of County Commissioners of DeSoto County, Florida, is authorized by the provisions of Chapter 316 Florida Statutes to prohibit or regulate certain classes or kinds of vehicles on public roads of the County Road System, and

WHEREAS,

the Board of County Commissioners of DeSoto County, Florida, has determined that the prohibition of through truck traffic by trucks with a rated load capacity in excess of one ton on Turner Avenue from State Road No. 70 north to State Road No. 35 (U.S. No. 17) is necessary to better protect public property, to enhance public safety, and to minimize the public expense of maintenance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of DeSoto County, Florida that:

Section 1 - Prohibitions

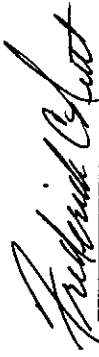
Through traffic trucks with a rated load-carrying capacity in excess of one (1) ton shall be prohibited at all times on Turner Avenue from State Road No. 70 north to State Road No. 35 (U.S. 17). For purposes of this Resolution through truck traffic shall apply to vehicles using said Turner Avenue which have a trip origin and destination beyond the limits of said Turner Avenue to which the prohibition applies. Through truck traffic does not apply to trucks intended for loading or unloading of cargo along said Turner Avenue or along public roads which intersect said Turner Avenue exclusively.

Section 2 - Posting

The Public Works Department of DeSoto County, Florida, is directed to post the truck traffic prohibited by the Resolution in accordance with the requirements of the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

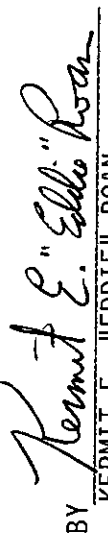
