#### ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT

County Administrator Mandy Hines read a letter from the 12th Circuit Court regarding the recent renovations to the third-floor courtroom. The Court expressed its appreciation for the exceptional work completed by Semco, noting that the renovation process was handled with professionalism and that the final result exceeded expectations. The letter also included a proposal to dedicate the newly renovated courtroom in honor of Judge Paker.

#### **COUNTY ATTORNEY'S REPORT**

The county attorney, Valerie Vicente reported that in the Giuseppe's litigation, three of the four corporate entities have been officially served, with one entity and Mr. Grossman still pending service. The served parties must respond by October 21 under Florida civil procedure rules. Once responses are received, the county can move forward with scheduling a court hearing. She also noted that Giuseppe's remains open despite the lawsuit, but further action depends on the court's schedule. Valerie additionally updated the board on attending the FLUEDRA mediation regarding the VCH, Osceola Organics matter. She plans to brief commissioners individually on the results and present a formal settlement proposal at the October 28, 2025 meeting.

#### **BOARD MEMBER COMMENTS**

The Board of County Commissioners expressed their appreciation to staff for their continued dedication and hard work. Commissioner Langford shared his positive impressions following a visit to the renovated Mills Building, noting its quality and commending the Road and Bridge Department for the exceptional landscaping. Commissioner Deriso also recognized the Road and Bridge staff for their diligent efforts in maintaining the county's roadways, ensuring they remain well-mowed and clear.
