

McAlpine Conditions 10/7/25

- All environmental permitting requirements shall be reflected on the Improvement Plan and copies of anyll required State and Federal permits or a letter of exemption shall be provided to the Development Department prior to issuance of the Notice to Proceed.
- Landscape buffers shall be consistent with Section 20-600 Buffer Matrix or Sec. 20-603
 Alternative Buffer Proposals and approved by the Development Department with the Improvement Plan.
- 3. Approval of a Transportation Analysis will be required with the Improvement Plan.
- 4. Stormwater engineering design and copies of State or Federal permit applications shall be provided with the Improvement Plan. The approved permits shall be provided prior to issuance of the Notice to Proceed.
- 5. The Improvement Plan shall designate usable open space per Section 20-144(f)(6) for Planned Unit Development projects and approved by the Development Department Open space shall be in substantial compliance with the approved concept plan.
- 6. The Improvement Plan shall show parking and bicycle racks, (in conformance with an applicant provided parking study) for the proposed amenity center and be approved by the Development Department.
- 7.6. The Improvement Plan shall show an internal neighborhood sidewalk extended to Lexington Place to the west and approved by the County Engineer.
