YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED THAT PURSUANT TO THE FINDING OF THE DESOTO COUNTY ANIMAL SERVICES, YOUR DOG, MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS: "Bruno" an intake male 2 year old brown/black Great Pyrenees mix.

HAS BEEN INITIALLY DETERMINED TO BE A DANGEROUS DOG. THIS DETERMINATION IS MADE BASED UPON THE FOLLOWING:

Pursuant to Section 767.11, Florida Statutes

You may request a hearing before a final determination is made as to the status of your dog as being dangerous or not. If you choose to request a hearing, you must do so in writing to the:

Be further advised, pursuant to Section 767.12(1)(c) Florida Statutes, that you have seven (7) calendar days from the date you have received this notification to make such a written request. The purpose of this hearing is to provide you with an opportunity to demonstrate that your dog is not dangerous. If you do not request in writing a hearing as described above, the initial determination of your dog as dangerous shall become a final declaration and you will be so notified in writing.
