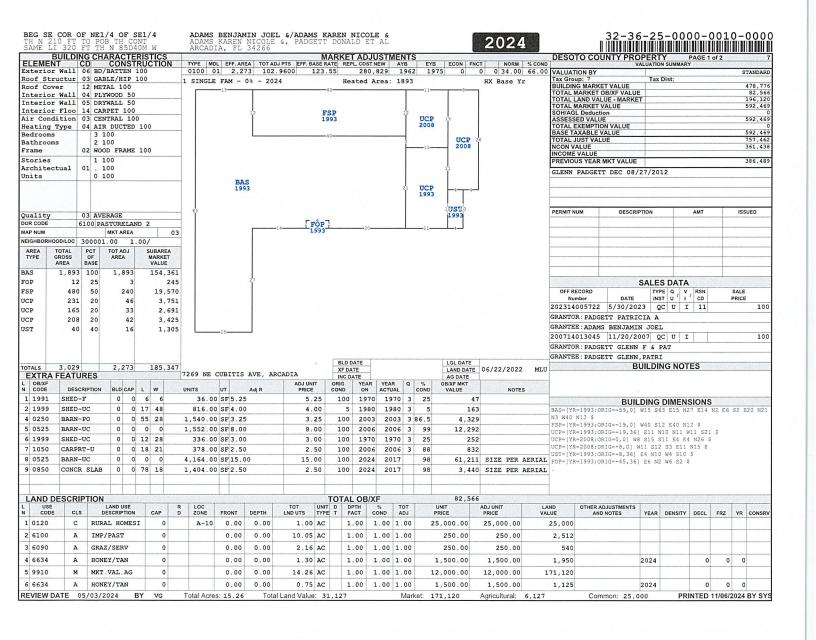

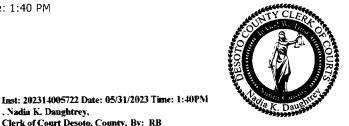

Sec. 20-126. - Agricultural 10 District (A-10).

The intent of the Agricultural 10 District (A-10) is primarily agricultural, pastoral, the extraction or processing of non-phosphate minerals, and low-density residential development. This district is designed to accommodate traditional agricultural uses and conservatory measures, where appropriate, while protecting the rural areas of the County. The regulations in this district are intended to permit a reasonable use of the property, at a gross density of one dwelling per ten acres. At the same time, the intent is to prevent the creation of conditions which would endanger damage or destroy the agricultural base of the County, the environmental resources of the County, the potable water supply and the wildlife resources. The first priority of this district is agricultural uses.

- (1) *Uses and structures.* No building or structure, or part thereof, shall be erected, altered or used, or land used, in whole or in part, for other than the following:
 - a. Permitted uses and structures (allowable without the need for any other use or structure).
 - 1. One single-family dwelling or residentially designed manufactured home per parcel; family day care home.
 - 2. Agricultural uses and related uses, such as, but not limited to: animal breeding, training, stabling; bee keeping; livestock grazing; field crops; fruit and nut production; forestry; gardening; aquaculture and commercial fisheries; aviary; egg and milk production; poultry production; citrus packing; feed lots; livestock sales facilities.
 - 3. Wildlife management areas, plant and wildlife conservancies, refuges and sanctuaries for domestic or non-exotic animals; botanical gardens.
 - 4. Wholesale plant nurseries, greenhouses, and accessory of garden supplies.
 - 5. Sale of agricultural products, roadside produce stands.
 - 6. Utility grade solar plant solar facility in compliance with F.S. 163.3205, as amended.
 - 7. Agricultural buildings, such as, but not limited to, barns, feed storage sheds, animal storage buildings, and agricultural equipment storage buildings.
 - 8. Agricultural support mobile home (one only) on a parcel of land no smaller than 40 acres, having an agricultural classification for ad valorem tax purposes, and occupied by a family supporting the agricultural operation.
 - 9. Bed and breakfast, agri-tourism related development.
 - 10. Veterinary hospital and clinic.
 - 11. Wholesale agricultural produce transfer stations (temporary use or permanent).
 - 12. Hunting cabin on a parcel of land no smaller than 40 acres.
 - 13. Private docks.
 - 14. Primitive tent camping for recreational, noncommercial purposes, that:

- (i) Is provided to the general public without a fee;
- (ii) Is provided to the general public without any associated water and/or sanitary facilities or improvements;
- (iii) Has a maximum of two primitive camping sites per acre; and
- (iv) Is limited to no more than seven days per calendar month per campsite.
- 15. The parking or storage of agricultural equipment and vehicles used for bona fide agricultural purposes by the property owner or lessee.
- 16. A banquet hall provided it is on property with a minimum size of 15-acres.
- 17. Electric substation in compliance with F.S. 163.3208, as amended.
- b. Accessory uses and structures.
 - 1. Accessory uses and structures which are incidental to and customarily associated with uses permitted in the district.
 - 2. Home occupations.
 - 3. Country clubs, tennis courts.
 - 4. Temporary occupancy of mobile home, RV, or accessory structure (see <u>Section 20-728(c)</u>).
 - 5. Guest house (see Section 20-660).
 - 6. Medical hardship mobile home (see <u>Section 20-728(e)</u>).
 - 7. Cemeteries, as an accessory use to a place of worship (see <u>Section 20-689</u> (a), (b) and (c)).
 - 8. Solar facility accessory uses may include administration or maintenance buildings, electric transmission lines, substations, energy storage equipment, and related accessory uses and structures.

 - 3. Communication transmitting and receiving facilities, non-occupied; minimum setback from any property boundary line equal to 100 percent of proposed tower height.
 - 4. Drag strips and race tracks.
 - 5. Oil and gas exploration, extraction, production and processing, sanitary landfills.
 - 6. Firing range (indoor or outdoor).
 - 7. Kenneling.

- 8. Place of worship.
- 9. Recreation and leisure, such as, but not limited to, parks and playgrounds; sports arenas; community and recreation centers; libraries; museums; marinas and/or boat rental facilities; zoo; sale of alcoholic beverages in connection with a restaurant in a golf course clubhouse.
- 10. Accessory apartment.
- 11. Golf course.
- 12. Excavation (other than phosphate) and related processes, earthmoving.
- 13. Funeral homes, refrigeration facilities as defined in F.S. § 497.005(68).
- 14. Parking or storage of commercial vehicles or equipment by a person engaged in the business of commercial repair of such vehicles or equipment in accordance with section 20-98(d).
- 15. Family cemeteries (see Section 20-689(d)).
- 16. Other similar uses which are comparable in nature with the foregoing.
- d. *Prohibited uses and structures.* Any use or structure not specifically or by reasonable implication allowed herein.

Jorge,

After looking in our LDR. There is no definition for sawmill. I have looked in the A Planners Dictionary, produced by American Planning Association. I have listed all the definitions that I found that are related to sawmill. Within A-10 or A-5, a sawmill is by Special Exception only. From all the definitions below a sawmill is a process that turns raw timber into other wood materials for use in other manufacturing. If a location is manufacturing products from the raw timber, then that is manufacturing and will need to be located within II or IH zoned district.

Anyone who operates a sawmill will need to apply for a Special Exception and go to public hearing for approval by the Board. Please let me know if you need anything else from me.

1. <u>sawmill</u> (See also forest industry; lumber manufacturing; lumberyard): A facility where logs or partially processed

cants are sawn, split, shaved, stripped, chipped, or otherwise processed to produce wood products, not including the

processing of timber for use on the same lot by the owner or resident of that lot. (Kent County, Md.)
A stationary or portable machine used in converting logs to lumber or ties or in refining lumber. (Marinette

County, Wisc.)

A facility for the processing of timber from the property on which it is located, from adjoining property, or from other

properties removed from the sawmill or its environs without regard to point of origination. (Campbell County,

Va.)

An operation or facility which has, as its predominant purpose, the sawing or planing of logs or trees into rough slabs.

A sawmill is sometimes referred to as a planing mill. (Concord, N.C.)

2. <u>sawmill, accessory</u>: A sawmill which is operated as an incident to a construction site or another industrial or retail

operation which is or will be established as a primary use on the same site. (Concord, N.C.)

3. <u>forest industry</u> (See also timber harvesting): The cutting and storing of forest products, the operation of portable sawmills and planers, the production of maple syrup and sugar. (Marinette County, Wisc.)

Any commercial activity relating to the growing and harvesting of forest tree species. (Deschutes County, Ore.)

The use of land for the raising and harvesting of timber, pulp woods, and other forestry products for commercial purposes, including the temporary operation

of a sawmill and/or chipper to process the timber cut from that parcel or contiguous parcels. Excluded from this definition shall be the cutting of timber associated

with land development approved by the [jurisdiction], which shall be considered accessory to the development of the property. (Blacksburg, Va.)

- 4. <u>lumber manufacturing</u> (See also forest industry; sawmill): Manufacturing, processing, and sales uses involving the milling of forest products to produce rough and finished lumber and other wood materials for use in other manufacturing, craft, or construction processes. (Rancho Mirage, Calif.)
- 5. <u>lumberyard</u> (See also home improvement center): A facility where building materials such as lumber, plywood, drywall, paneling, cement blocks and other

cement products, and other building products are stored and sold. Lumberyards may also process lumber by performing millwork, planing, cutting, and

other customizing processes. Lumber yards may provide for the sale of associated products including tools and fasteners. (Waukesha, Wisc.)

An area used for the storage, distribution, and sale of finished or rough-cut lumber and lumber products, but not including the manufacture or fabrication of lumber,

lumber products, or firewood. (Siskiyou County, Calif.)

An establishment where lumber and other building materials such as brick, tile, cement, insulation, roofing materials, and the like are sold at retail. The sale of

items, such as heating and plumbing supplies, electrical supplies, paint, glass, hardware, and wallpaper is permitted at retail and deemed to be customarily incidental to the sale of lumber and other building materials at retail. (Hartford, Conn.; Loveland, Colo.)

- 6. <u>timber harvesting</u> (See also clear-cutting; forest industry; logging yard): The cutting and removal of trees from their growing site, and the attendant operation of cutting and skidding machinery but not the construction or creation of roads. Timber harvesting does not include the clearing of land for construction approved under this ordinance. (Limington, Maine) The commercial cutting of timber.(Campbell County, Va.)
- 7. <a href="https://doi.org/10.10/10.10-10

An establishment selling various house hold goods, tools, and building materials, durable household goods (e.g., refrigerators, lawn care machines, washing machines), electronic equipment, house hold animal supplies, nursery products, etc. Retail stock (e.g., nursery items, lumber goods) may be kept outdoors. All such stock (except plant materials) shall be screened in accordance with the [city ordinance]. At least 75 percent of all indoor floor-good space shall be for retail sales. (Gastonia, N.C.)

The retail sale of a diverse range of hardware and related materials generally used in the maintenance, repair, or construction of buildings or other structures, including lawn and garden supplies. (Nashville and Davidson County, Tenn.)

An establishment providing the sale or rental of building supplies, construction equipment, or home decorating fixtures and accessories. This term includes a lumber yard or a contractors' building supply business and may include outdoor storage or tool and equipment sales or rental. This term does not include an establishment devoted exclusively to the retail sale of paint, wallpaper, or hardware or activities classified under vehicle/equipment sales and services, including vehicle towing services. (Milwaukee, Wisc.)

Retail establishments selling lumber and other large building materials, where most display and sales occur indoors. Includes paint, wallpaper, glass, fixtures, nursery stock, and lawn and garden supplies. Includes all these stores selling to the general public, even if contractor sales account for a major proportion of total sales. Includes incidental retail ready-mix concrete operations, except where excluded by a specific zoning district. (Truckee, Calif.)
